

University of Northern Iowa Select Scholarships

The University of Northern Iowa offers a variety of scholarships to high-achieving students who have demonstrated outstanding academic performance during their high school career. The following scholarships are available to incoming freshmen and are awarded annually. For a full list of scholarships visit the UNI Scholarship Application at www.uni.edu/finaid

Presidential Scholarships

- Must rank in the top 10% of high school graduating class, have a composite ACT of 29 or SAT-CR&M of 1280 or RAI of 335 or above; renewable.
- Amount: \$8,000

Bright Scholars of Iowa

- Must rank in top 10% of high school graduating class, or RAI of 299 or above, or composite ACT of 28 or above; commitment to learning and community service; demonstrate success in face of diversity; qualify for Federal Pell Grant. Priority to a child for whom neither parent has earned a four-year college degree; renewable.
- Amount: Tuition & fees, room & board and books

Ben and Pat Allen Scholarships

- Minimum of 2.5 high school GPA; preference to Iowa residents.
- Amount: \$4,000

College of Business Administration (CBA) Scholarships

CBA Scholar Awards

- Plan to major in one of the CBA degree programs; ACT of 27 or higher on both math and composite scores; renewable.
- Amount: \$500 to \$7,000
- Deadline: December 15

College of Education (COE) Scholarships

- Plan to major in one of the COE degree programs; ACT of 26 or higher and rank in top 25% of high school graduating class; renewable.
- Amount: \$3,000 to \$5,000

COE Dean's Teacher of Color Scholar Awards

- Plan to major in one of the COE degree programs; ethnic or racial status of African-American/Black, Hispanic/Latino/Alaskan Native or American Indian, Asian, Native Hawaiian Pacific Islander or blended heritage, and minimum ACT of 23 or SAT 1070 or RAI of 290 or above; renewable.
- Amount: \$4,000

Benjamin J. Allen Teacher Education Scholar Awards

- Plan to major in one of the COE degree programs; minimum ACT of 26; Iowa resident; renewable.
- Amount: Up to in-state tuition

College of Humanities, Arts and Sciences (CHAS) Scholarships

Dean's Scholarships

- Minimum ACT of 27; rank in the upper 15% of high school graduating class; plan to major in one of the following: Art, Communication Studies, Communication Sciences & Disorders, Languages & Literatures, Music, Philosophy & World Religions or Theatre; renewable.
- Amount: Up to \$6,000

Art Scholarships

- Admission to UNI, portfolio review. Visit www.uni.edu/chas/academics/art for specific details.
- Amount: Up to \$6,000

School of Music (SOM) Scholarships

- Admission to UNI and SOM. (Auditions required for admission to SOM); Selective scholarships are available for non-music majors. Renewable. Visit www.uni.edu/chas/academics/music-school for specific details.
- Amount: Up to \$6,000

Theatre Activity Scholarships

- Admission to UNI; "B" average or rank in the upper 30% of high school graduating class at the time of application. Compete for scholarships at annual Scholarship Day. Visit www.uni.edu/chas/academics/theatre for specific details.
- Amount: Up to \$2,500

Science Technology & Mathematics Scholarships

- Plan to major in one of the following: Biology, Chemistry & Biochemistry, Earth Science, Computer Science, Earth Science, Industrial Technology, Mathematics or Physics; renewable.
- Amount: Up to \$6,000

James W. Kercheval Memorial Scholarships

- Serious interest in pursuing a major and career in Chemistry or Biochemistry.
- Amount: \$5,000 to \$8,000

College of Social & Behavioral Sciences (CSBS) Scholarships

CSBS Scholar Awards

- Academic achievement; plan to major in one of the CSBS degree programs; renewable.
- Amount: Up to \$6,000

CSBS Multicultural Scholar Awards

- Underrepresented racial, cultural or ethnic background, plan to major in one of the CSBS degree programs; academic achievement; financial need may be considered; renewable.
- Amount: \$500 to \$5,000

Alderman Scholarships

- Academic achievement; plan to major in one of the CSBS degree programs; awarded to needy, worthy and appreciative students who have experienced difficulties; renewable.
- Amount: Up to \$6,000
